

**Troy Township
Salary Committee Meeting Notes
Monday, July 20, 2020

Committee Chairman John Theobald called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Administrator Dylk distributed the current benefit costs (health premium, dental premium, vision premium, and HRA) for the township as well as a chart showing the salary and benefits of the elected officials for several surrounding townships.

Clerk Kristin Cross arrived as an audience member at 6:09 p.m.


