

**Minutes of the Troy Township Public Hearing**  
**Monday, April 20, 2020**  
**7:00 pm**

Troy Township Public Hearing held at the Troy Township Community Center, 25448 Seil Road, Shorewood, Illinois.

Supervisor Joseph D. Baltz called the meeting to order and read the following statement:

*This evenings' Public Hearing and Regular Township Board meetings are being held consistent with Executive Order #2020-07 which was ordered by Governor Pritzker on March 16, 2020 in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. This order addresses the provisions of the Open Meetings Act, 5 ILCS 120, requiring or relating to in-person attendance by members of a public body. Specifically, (1) the requirement in 5 ILCS 120/2.01 that "members of a public body must be physically present" is suspended; and (2) the conditions in 5 ILCS 120/7 limiting when remote participation is permitted are suspended. Public bodies are encouraged to postpone consideration of public business where possible. When a meeting is necessary, public bodies are encouraged to provide video, audio, and/or telephonic access to meetings to ensure members of the public may monitor the meeting, and to update their websites and social media feeds to keep the public fully apprised of any modifications to their meeting schedules or the format of their meetings due to COVID-19, as well their activities relating to COVID-19. Executive Order 2020-10, ordered by Governor Pritzker also prohibits the gathering of more than 10 people.*

*The format of these meetings will be the same as other board meetings held by this body. For any members of the public on the phone or video, please mute your device, if possible, and please refrain from any comments until the designated public comment and public hearing portions of the agenda. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in this matter. We have also provided the public with the opportunity to email questions or comments relative to tonight's meeting that will be read into the minutes and addressed as applicable. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and lead by Clerk Kristin Cross.

Supervisor Baltz stated that this is a public hearing for the fiscal year 2020-2021 Road District budget and appropriation ordinance 20-21-01 and for fiscal year 2020-2021 Township budget and appropriation ordinance 20-21-02.

Supervisor Baltz asked for any citizen comments. After asking two more times the meeting was closed for citizen comments.

Supervisor Baltz opened the meeting for review of the Road and Bridge budget and appropriation ordinance 20-21-01. No comments or questions were made.

Supervisor Baltz opened the meeting for review of the Town Fund budget and appropriation ordinance 20-21-02 including the Town Budget, Assessor Budget, and General Assistance Budget. No comments or questions were made.

Supervisor Baltz asked for any other general discussion of the Road and Bridge budget and appropriation ordinance 20-21-01 or the Town Fund budget and appropriation ordinance 20-21-02. No comments were made.

Motion made by Trustee Ryan; seconded by Trustee Kopman to adopt Ordinance 20-21-01 an Ordinance Appropriating for all Road Purposes for Troy Road District, Will County, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2020, and ending March 31, 2021. Supervisor Baltz reported for the record that the total appropriations of Ordinance 20-21-01 were \$1,582,445.00. Roll call vote: Kopman – Aye; Ryan–Aye; Theobald–Aye; Wheeler–Absent; Baltz–Aye. 4 Ayes, 0 Nays, 1 Absent. Motion Carried.


Motion made by Trustee Kopman; seconded by Trustee Theobald to adopt Ordinance 20-21-02 an Ordinance Appropriating for all Town Purposes and General Assistance for Troy Township, Will County, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2020, and ending March 31, 2021. Supervisor Baltz reported for the record that the total appropriations for the General Town Fund totaled \$1,180,775.00 and for General Assistance \$66,335.00 for total appropriations of \$1,247,110.00 for Ordinance 20-21-02. Roll call vote: Kopman – Aye; Ryan–Aye; Theobald–Aye; Wheeler–Absent; Baltz–Aye. 4 Ayes, 0 Nays, 1 Absent. Motion Carried.

Supervisor Baltz asked for any further discussion. No further discussion was brought forward.

Clerk Cross asked Administrator Dylik if any comments had been emailed to [information@troystownship.com](mailto:information@troystownship.com) that needed to be read into the record. Dylik confirmed that no emails had been received.

Motion made by Trustee Theobald; seconded by Trustee Ryan to adjourn. Roll call vote: Kopman – Aye; Ryan–Aye; Theobald–Aye; Wheeler–Absent; Baltz–Aye. 4 Ayes, 0 Nays, 1 Absent. Motion Carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:13 p.m.
