Troy Township Seniors General Guidelines

- All seniors are encouraged to volunteer for kitchen duties once a month. All volunteer hours for charity outside of the center will be honored as well. All volunteer hours are to be recorded at the seniors sign in table in the community room. When volunteering at the center, two hours will be allowed for kitchen duties and one hour for miscellaneous duties.
- Once a year a list of all Troy Township Senior members will be provided.
- Pop and bottled water are kept in the back refrigerator and is available for purchase for \$0.35 each. The money overage from the sale of pop and water is used to buy greeting cards, get well cards and stamps.
- Get well cards will be sent to seniors who are hospitalized or out sick for an extended length of time.
- In the case of a death in the senior's immediate family, a sympathy card will be sent. Flowers will only be sent for a senior or his/her spouse.
- The Troy Township seniors have a five (5) member board. Every March one person will leave the board and the Troy Township Seniors will elect a replacement. Seniors will be asked to nominate people and the following week the seniors will be given ballots for voting. Each board member will serve for four years.
- Questions or suggestions for the board, no matter how small, should be brought up to any board member or put in the suggestion box. These questions will be discussed at the next board meeting and all questions will be answered to the best of the board's ability.

Optional Troy Township Senior Club

Some Troy Township Seniors may choose to pay dues and doing so will receive the following benefits:

1. When the seniors take trips outside of the center, part of the cost for the trip will be paid for by their dues. Non-dues paying seniors will pay the full cost of the outing.
 2. When the seniors have the December Christmas lunch at a local restaurant, part of the cost will be paid by their dues. Non-dues paying seniors will pay the full cost of the lunch.
- Dues are \$5.00 per month and may be paid semi-monthly, monthly or annually to the treasurer, on or before the first Wednesday of each month.
 - Only seniors whose dues are paid up to date are eligible to receive benefits stated in #1 and #2 above.
 - Seniors who are five (5) months in arrears of paying dues will be reminded so they may bring their dues up to date.
